

# Turning

The turning radius of a trailer and “trailer swing” is based on the position of the tandems. Tandems in the forward position allow you to make some turns you can not make with the tandems in the rear position. You need to know the position before you drive to reduce the potential for hitting cars, posts, building or other objects.
